


**Can You Make CHANGE? #13**




Ivy went to the pet store to buy food for her dog. The food cost \$21.24. If she gave the cashier forty dollars, how much change should she get back?


Theo bought a present for his best friend. If the present cost \$18.08 and Theo paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he receive?
